Drop Off/ Pick up: Student drop off and pick up will take place at the social hall door. A parent will need to either walk their student to the building or drive up to the main door. No students should walk through the parking lot alone.

Late Arrival/ Early Pick up: The building will be on lockdown from 6:10-7:15pm. You will need to knock on the Faith Formation door to be let into the building if you are dropping off late or picking up a student early from class. This is for the safety of all our students and volunteers.

All parents and family members are encouraged to attend. On days when we end with a prayer service students should be picked up from the church.
